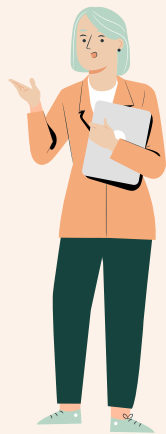

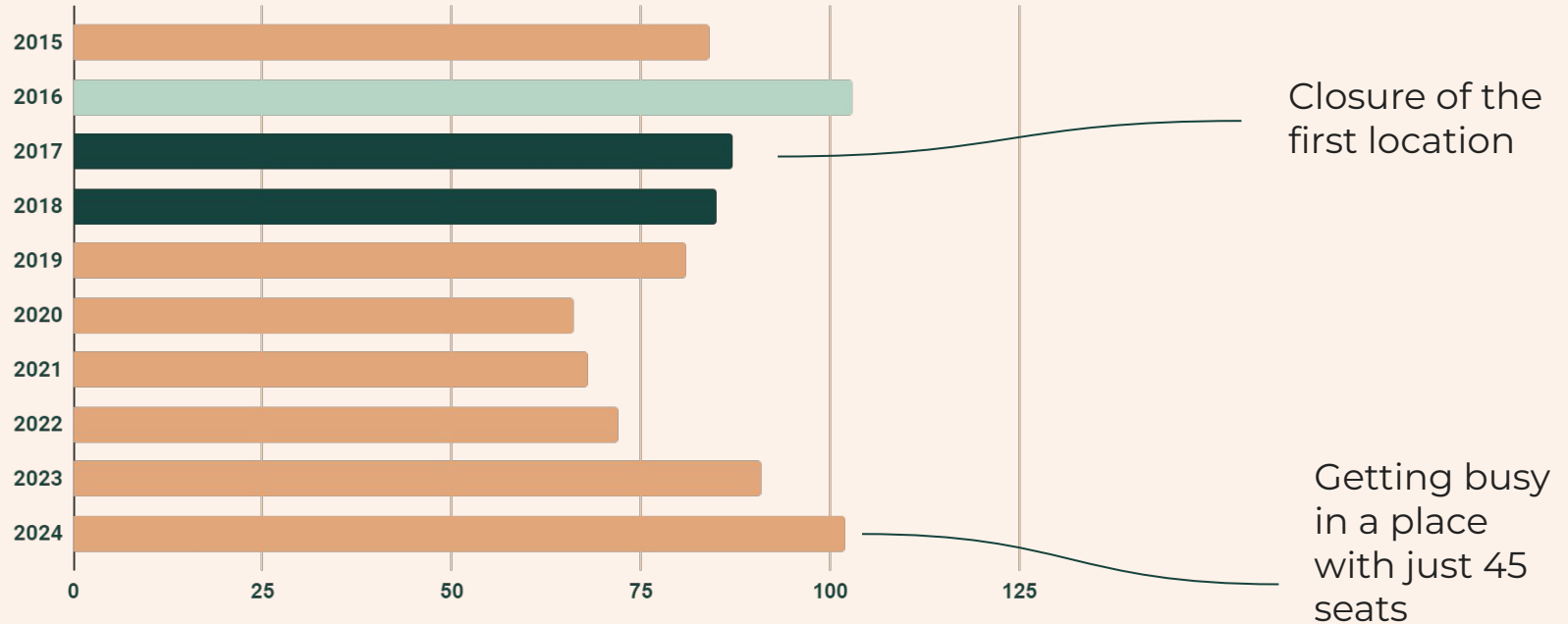

Our member count



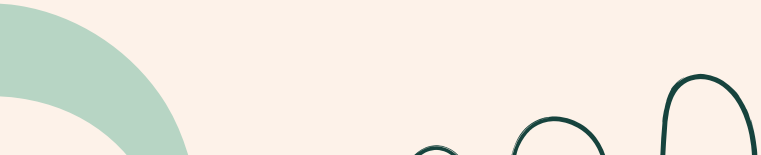
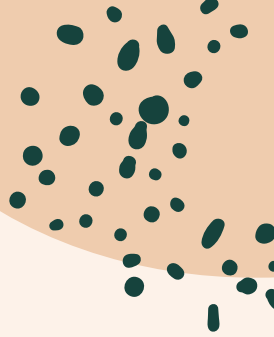
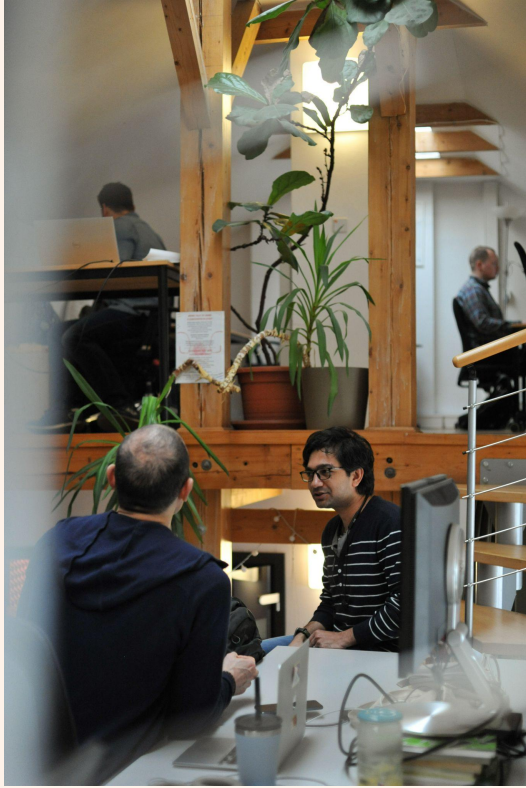

- We welcome all individuals with open arms and a non-judgmental spirit


2 / 4 Actively connect people with each other

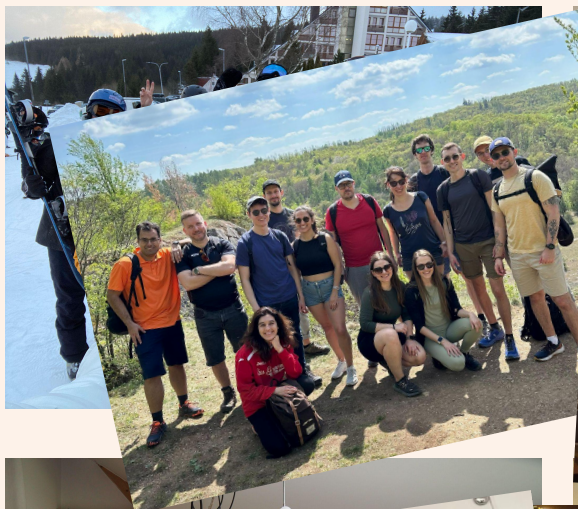


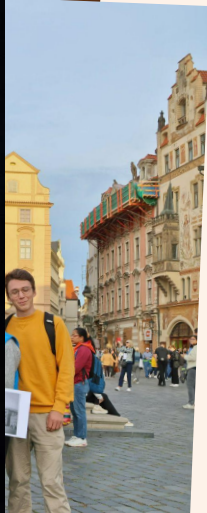
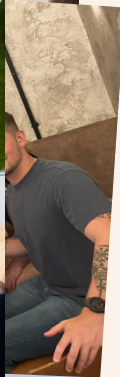
